DEPARTMENT OF WOMEN & CHILD DEVELOPMENT HIGHLIGHTS OF LAST ONE YEAR

Detailed guidelines developed and circulated in the Central and State Governments to promote adoption of a gender perspective in all public expenditure and policy. A Bill for the constitution of a National Commission for Protection of Child Rights introduced in Parliament. Bill on Protection from Domestic Violence to be shortly introduced in the Parliament. Law for prevention of sexual harassment of women at work place is also in the process of finalization. A virtual resource centre and digital library on women and gender issues has been opened in the National Resource Centre for Women. To universalize integrated child development services scheme, 467 additional projects and 1,88,168 additional *Anganwadi* centres are in the process of being established. Centre to support States by providing 50 per cent of expenditure incurred by them on supplementary nutrition in plan allocation 2005-06. 19 ICDS projects and 6817 Anganwadi centres sanctioned for J&K reconstruction plan. High level group set up to address education, women and child development issues in Northeastern Region. Swashakti and Mahila Samakhya projects further strengthened to empower women. Students of standard VIII to X belonging to Kendriya Vidyalayas and Navodaya Vidyalayas across the country are being sensitized against the evil practice of female foeticide through awareness material for teachers.
