

**Bus services between India and Pakistan**

**New Delhi Agrahayana 17, 1927  
December 08, 2005**

So far only one point-to-point bus service between India and Pakistan, namely, Delhi-Lahore bus service (being operated by Delhi Transport Corporation) is in operation. In addition, in Srinagar, there is an arrangement since 7<sup>th</sup> April, 2005 of buses plying upto LOC and allowing passengers to cross the border and board the bus on the other side of LOC to reach Muzaffarabad. This service is being operated by Jammu and Kashmir State Road Transport Corporation between Srinagar and LOC.

As per information made available by Delhi Transport Corporation (DTC) and Jammu & Kashmir State Road Transport Corporation (JKSRTC), DTC has earned a revenue of Rs. 2,39,28,137/- during the period 11-07-2003 to 31-10-2005 and JKSRTC has earned a revenue of Rs. 8,49,000/- till date.

As per information provided by DTC and JKSRTC, they have carried 17740 and 707 number of passengers respectively.

This information was given by the Minister of State for Shipping, Road Transport and Highways, Shri K.H. Muniyappa in a written reply in the Rajya Sabha today.
