

ENTRY DATE FOR BHARATENDU HARISHCHANDRA AWARDS EXTENDED

New Delhi, November 9,2005

The last date for receipt of entries for Bharatendu Harishchandra Awards for 2004 has been extended by one month to November 30, 2005. Under this scheme, Publications Division, Ministry of Information & Broadcasting honours the published books/manuscripts written in Hindi on Journalism and Mass Communication, Women's Issues, National Integration and Children's Literature.

The awards are open to all Indian authors, who can send their published books and typed manuscripts for acceptance. Books/manuscripts written during the period from 1st January, 2004 to 31st December, 2004 will be considered.

The entries should be sent to Assistant Director (OL), Room No. 342, Publications Division, Soochna Bhawan, C.G.O. Complex, Lodi Road, New Delhi-110003 in the prescribed proforma duly filled in, alongwith six copies of the book/manuscript, two unstamped envelopes of 10x22 cms. size and brief life sketch in not more than 100 words. If less than six copies of the book/manuscript are received, the entry will be rejected. The request for rules, regulations and entry forms must be accompanied with an unstamped self-addressed envelope of 10x22 cms. size. All correspondence in this regard should be addressed to Assistant Director (OL) at the above noted address.
